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

## House & Senate Budget Proposals

- **Racial Truth & Reconciliation Virginia:**

- **Virginia HEALS** - The budget committees preserved the funding in the Governor's initial proposal for Virginia HEALS, **\$517,553** in FY22 to provide general fund support to the Virginia Helping Everyone Access Services (HEALS) program.
  - **ACEs Interface** - The Senate restored **\$143,000** in funding for ACEs Interface.
  - **MARCUS Alert system** - The Senate included language to develop and review a plan to implement the MARCUS Alert system established by House Bill 5043 and Senate Bill 5038 from the 2020 Special Session.
