



Public + Connected Open Spaces

How does the Plan propose to improve the open space network in AlexWest?

First, the Plan recommends access improvements to the Winkler Botanical Preserve, James Mulligan Park, and the Stonegate Scenic Easement to make it easier for residents to take advantage of these existing open space resources. Second, the Plan recommends approximately 60 acres of new parks and public open spaces with redevelopment in the Focus Area. Planned parks will be further reinforced and connected with planned trails and greenways to allow residents to travel more easily and conveniently between parks.

How does the Plan improve equitable access to parks and recreation facilities?

Planned parks provide new options for residents who are not currently within a 20-minute walk from a park or open space, filling a significant access gap in the Plan area's open space resources. The Plan also recommends a new recreation facility, filling a need for full time recreational and community activities and services in this area of the City.

A variety of park amenities responsive to community needs will be provided within the planned parks as specified in the Neighborhood development tables located in Chapter 8 of the Plan, and as illustrated below.
