Open Space Master Plan


Goal 9 - Create Public Open Space from Vacant Land

- Preserve, protect, and enhance vacant lands as public open space amenities.
- Undertake a detailed survey of all vacant lands, rights-of-way, and alleys/street ends in order to understand the City's potential open space opportunities for these sources.
- Work collaboratively with other citywide interests (e.g., schools, and affordable housing advocates) to define a strategy from which everyone stands to gain in the definition/use of vacant properties.
- Reference conservation easements and other protection measures as a precursor to acquisition.



404A, 406, 408 ROW Details

- 6,305 SF = 0.15 AC
- Location: Residential neighborhood
- Zone: R2-5 Residential Family
- SAP: Potomac West Small Area Plan
- Neighborhood: Del Ray, Alexandria










Pocket Park at 2304 East Randolph Ave More Information






Lynhaven Gateway Park


Pocket Park at 101 Lynhaven Drive More Information

Goal 9 Implementation

- Update & Verify: Ensure all Open Space Master Plan R/Ws and Open Spaces are accurately identified and updated as needed.
- Confirm Maintenance: Validate that all spaces are maintained by the city and address any gaps.
- Evaluate & Assign Uses: Assess each R/W and Open Space to designate preferred uses for optimal community benefit.
- Clarify Ownership: Communicate clearly that all R/Ws and Open Spaces are recognized as City property.
