Background Information

- Before the PARKnership Program, community group partnerships were viewed as a valuable means of connecting with residents around a shared vision for Alexandria's parks and programs.
- In 2015, the PARKnership Program was launched to establish partnerships with community organizations for one-time or ongoing donations of money, time, or resources to the Department.
- The PARKnerships Program represents the City's first concerted effort to streamline and actively pursue partnerships.
- The PARKnership Manager was hired in February 2016 to oversee and guide the program.

 - Support specific capital improvement projects identified in Park Framework Plans
 - Coordinate and staff educational or interpretive park or recreational programs
 - Conduct research on the park's natural resources
 - Provide ongoing volunteer maintenance of trails

Sponsorships

Adopt-a-Bench

- Residents and organizations can donate to the fund and adopt a bench.
- This offers a meaningful opportunity to honor a friend or loved one by dedicating a bench in one of our parks.
- Proceeds from the bench program support the Living Landscape Fund, helping to fund park improvements.





Area of Focus



Volunteers

- Many City programs rely on volunteer support to provide essential services to residents.
- Volunteers are valued members of the Alexandra community, making meaningful impact through their service.
- The PARKnerships Program serves as a liaison within the department, connecting volunteers with opportunities in our parks and facilities.





Area of Focus



Partnerships

 A partnership is a collaborative effort between two or more parties working toward a common goal, such as capital improvements or program enhancements.

In FY 2024 we had a total of 32 partnerships, including:

- Miracle League Scoreboard
- Alexandria Soccer Association Bottle Fillers at Ben Brenman and Ft. Ward turf soccer fields
- Hoop Life Free basketball and e-sports programming
- Eagle Scout Projects Outdoor seating for seniors and beautification of public spaces.





Area of Focus



Adopt-a-Park

- The Adopt-a-Park program is a collaborative effort between the Commonwealth of Virginia, the City of Alexandria, and residents to enhance the appearance and condition of Alexandria's small urban parks and open spaces.
- Community groups commit to monitoring and cleaning their adopted park at least once a week from April through November, helping to maintain and beautify these vital community spaces.





Area of Focus



The Community Matching Fund

- RPCA established the Community Matching Fund with the approval of the FY 2017-FY 2026 Capital Improvement Budget.
- In FY25, RPCA will give 1:1 matching award in an amount up to \$50,000, which allows a minimum of two selected proposals. Awards may vary given in any amount between \$5,000 (for project totals of \$10,000) to \$50,000 (for project totals for \$100,000).
- The Fund promotes collaborative partnerships among City of Alexandria community organizations.
